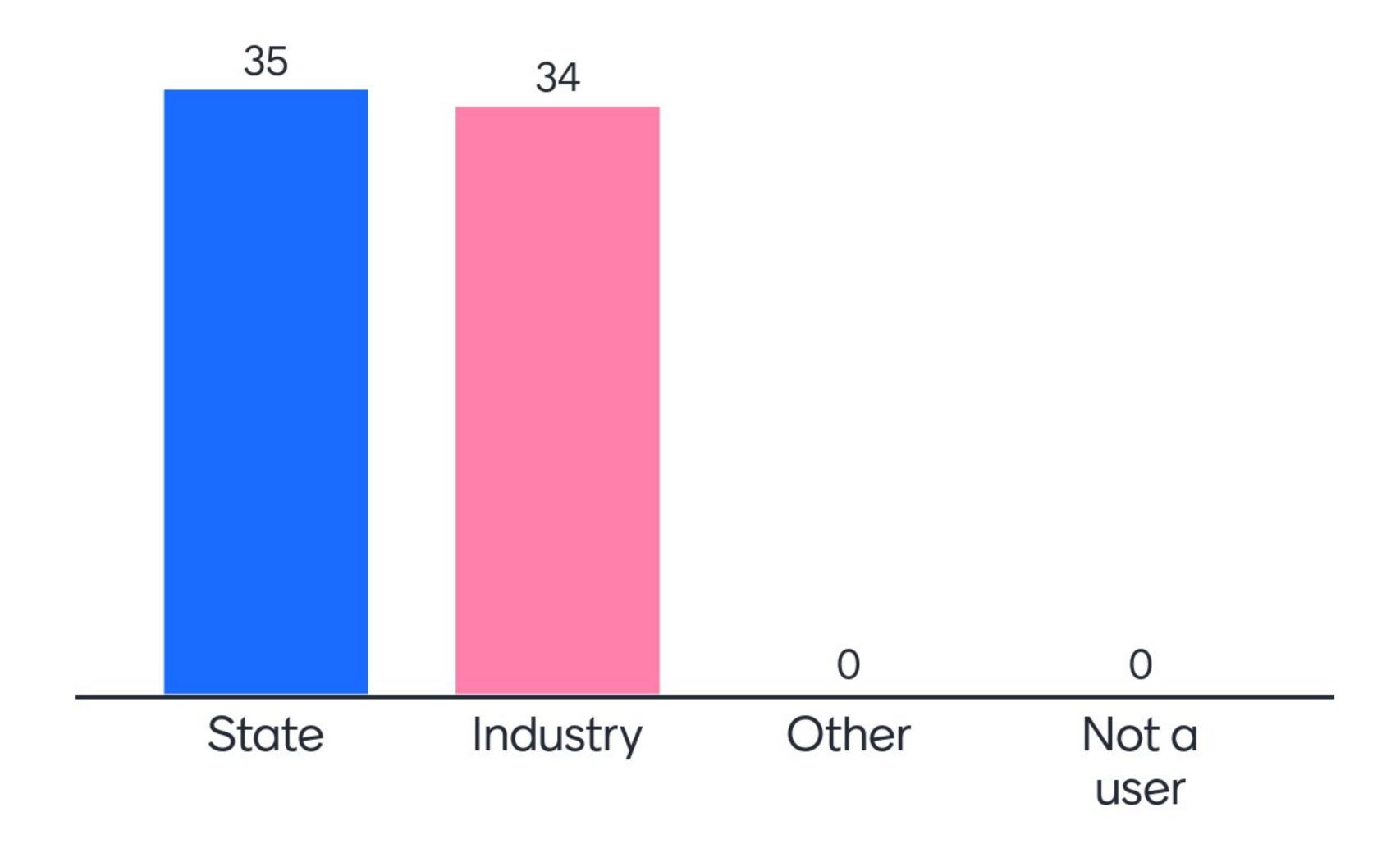

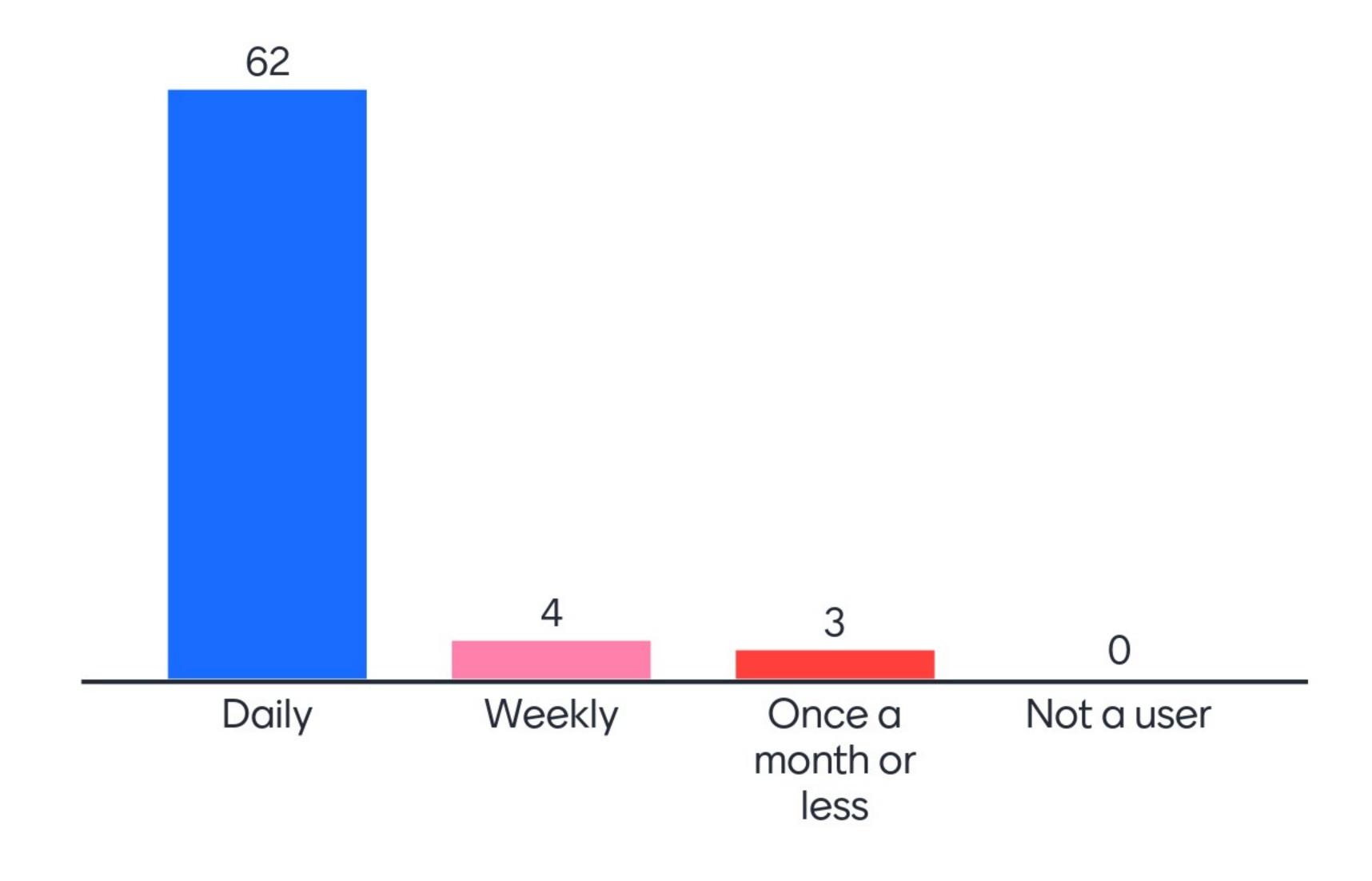


What type of user are you?

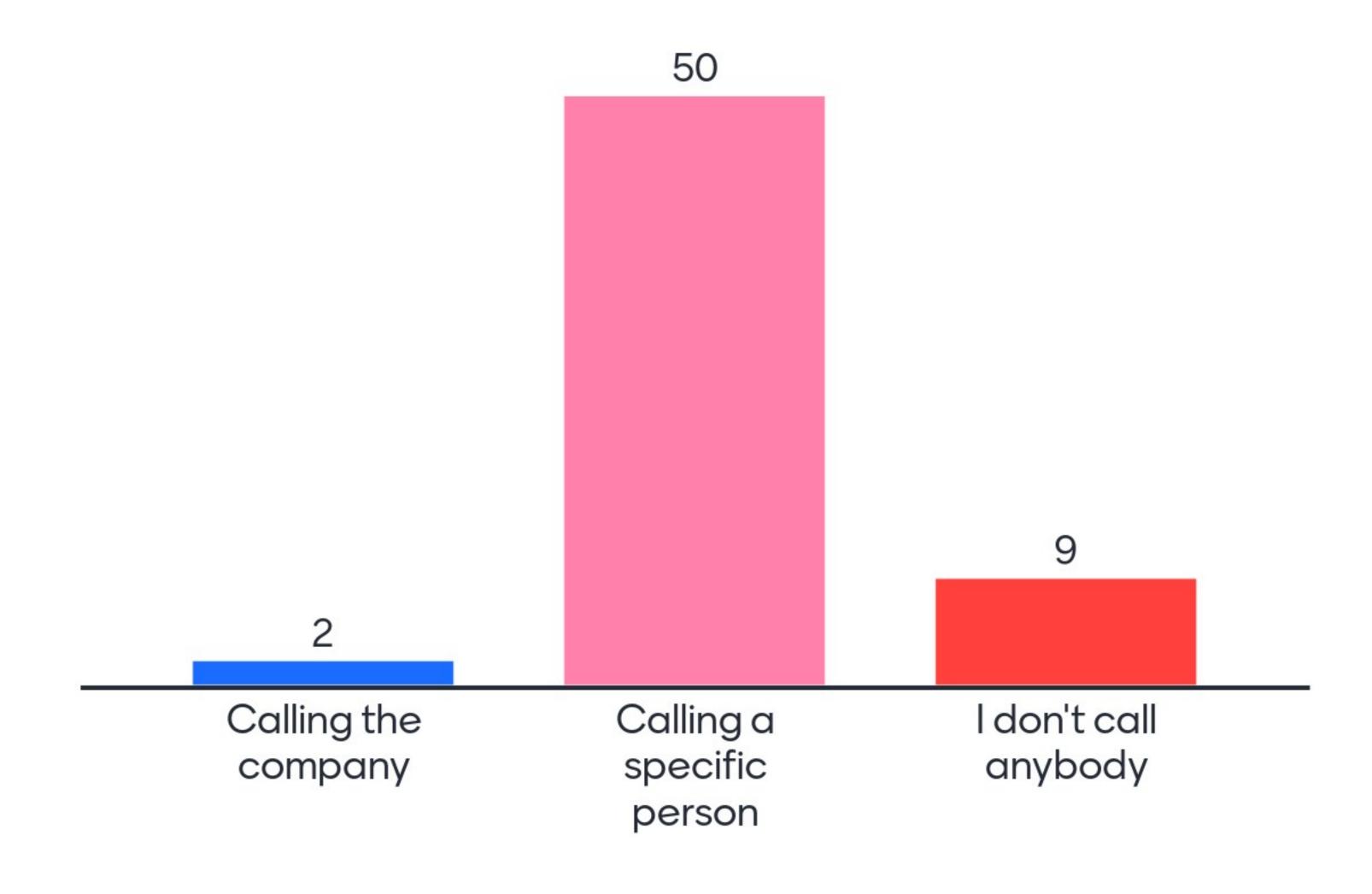


How important are the following ways you use company address?

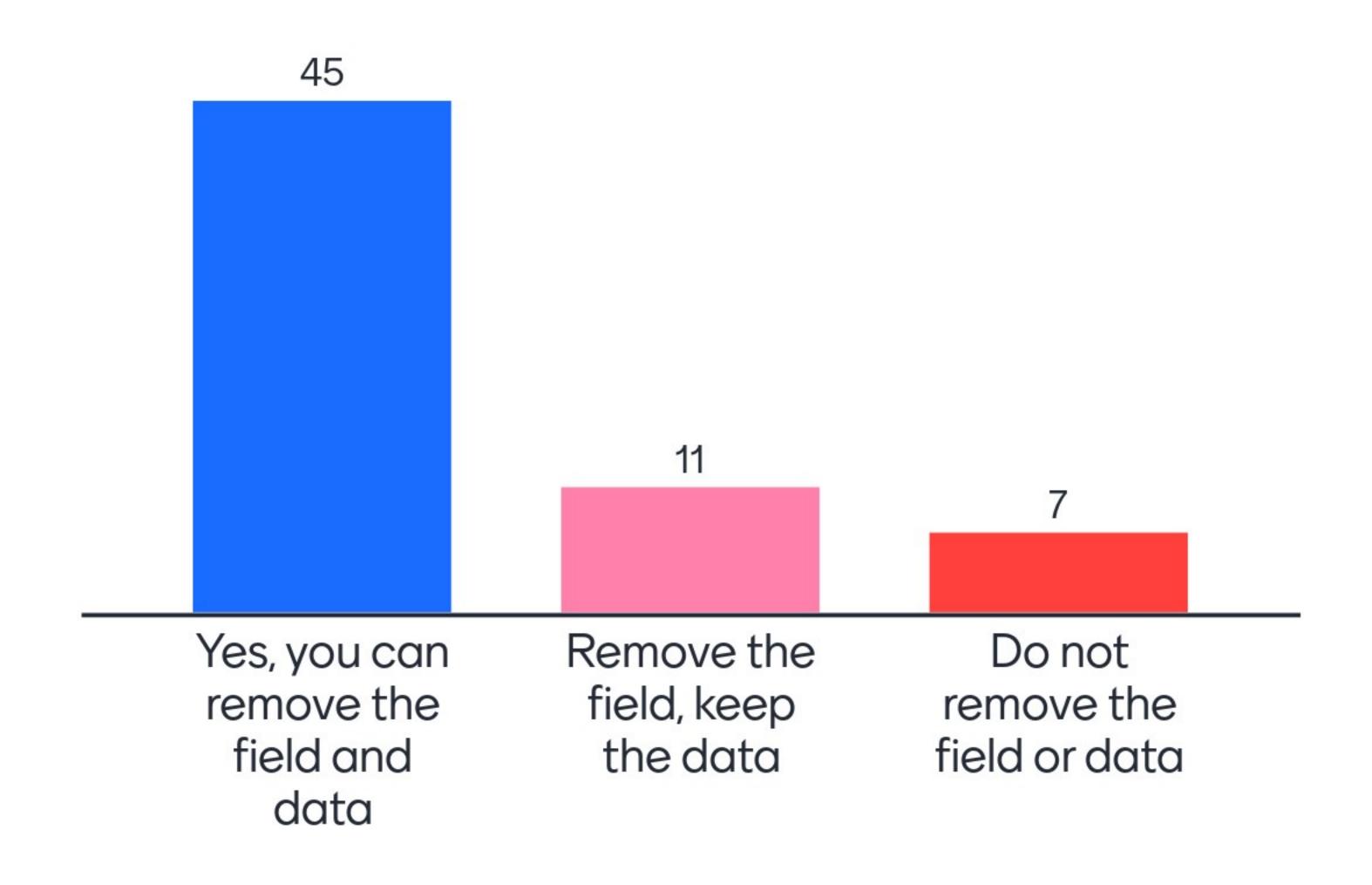


When you call a company, are you calling the company as a whole or a specific person related to the filing?



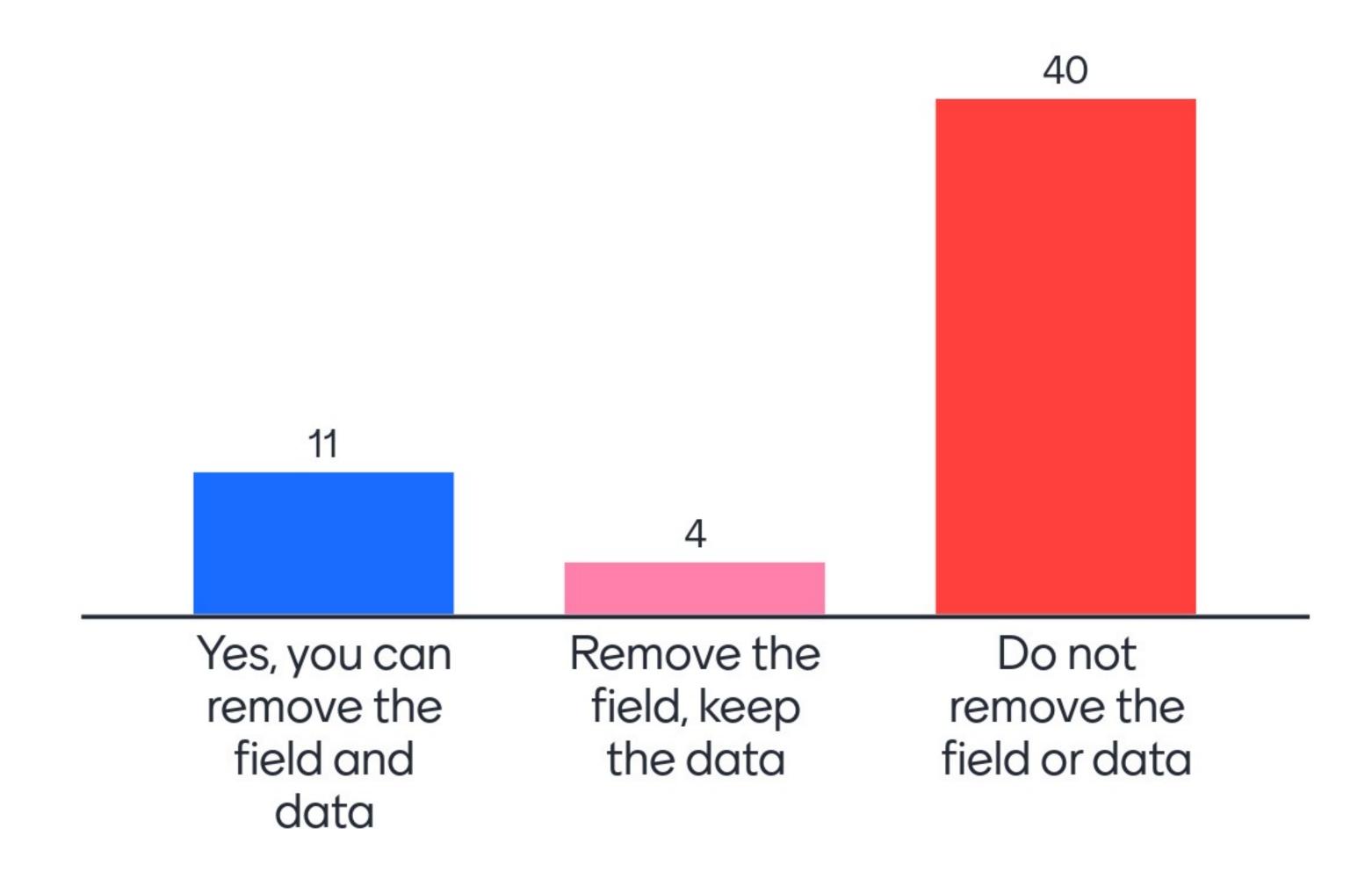

Company Set-Up/Management



What problems could arise if we pull company demographic data from the NAIC Company database?

Group information could not be correct if NAIC does not update it on their end. Happened a few times to us.

Unfortunately we often find the company contact information is not updated - frequently causes problems

Depends on what the demographic data is used for

The phone number for the company is not always the same as a specific phone number for the contact of the filing being submitted.

If you are talking auto populating, the wrong office/contact could be listed in the company contact information (if I am understanding this question correctly).

With our companies, there is a different address and phone # for our filings unit than the statutory address associated with the company.

Inaccurate information due to a lack of updates or user error

The contact and phone numbers for SERFF may be different than the NAIC Company database.

Differences between operating address and state of domicile.



What problems could arise if we pull company demographic data from the NAIC Company database?

I don't see any issues with this

contact info may not be updated which may pose a problem for fees if domicile state is not correct

What if the CoCode does not exist and there is no NAIC number related to the entity filer then nothing would pull back.

Depends on the search

Not a problem. How often would this be done, as we occasionally change our address info. Also, we have just been acquired by another company and most likely our addresses for our various companies will be updated.

Wrong company could be selected.

many things, such as phone numbers, contact info. and more things I am sure may not be correct.

NAIC number may have been used for another company where the company name changed.

may not have a co code, if acquiring another company



What problems could arise if we pull company demographic data from the NAIC Company database?

Sometimes the company will elect to use an address and phone number that is different than the address and phone number associated with their domiciliary address.

If the company is already set up on another instance, would there be problems getting it approved for the new instance?

What if we have a merger or name change?

What if there was a name change? Or a name change is in process.

N/A if this is just for setting up companies - but a thought that it could be problematic because of the multiple types of address/contact information stored in NAIC database - might not correspond to company's form/rate filing context.

Who updates the company information?

State Filings Supervisor or Regulatory Services Officer.

We have one person that updates the company information for SERFF.

We don't know and sometimes the filers don't know who updates that information.

SERFF Administrator for the Instance.

Depends on how the company has been organized. Could be one or multiple people

Appears to come from the annual & quarterly statements

Config Mgr

Configuration Manager - Usually one person within our group of companies.

We have one admin for all of our instances, for the entire company(s).



Who updates the company information?

Industry Configuration Manager - Normally department manager

From a regulator standpoint, it would be nice to know "current contact/contact info" for historical filings.

The information is updated when we experience internal changes. The SERFF Administrator is notified and the changes are made.

Changes are made on an as needed basis.

How does the maintenance process go? When do you know that updates need to be made?

varies

Depends on the updates being made, can come from meetings and discussion of new company, or changes to existing, or may be notified from other areas of company.

This is not a difficult process to make a change. Typically a corporate legal dept person will notify me that a change is needed

Either when we are aware of changes internally and we handle proactively OR for those pickier states, when they send an objection to indicate that the name got cut off or something odd.

When, based on when we are notified by accounting. Never had an issue from an objection.

Legal, Company Licensing

very simple to update. A Filing lead will communicate the need for the update



How does the maintenance process go? When do you know that updates need to be made?

As we are made aware by our clients, updates are made in SERFF.

A company person tells us about the amended information.

Usually, when it is noticed by either a filer or a state reviewer that it needs an update.

When i am made aware of changes such as a new address i generally know ahead of time because of all the other affects items

Should be identified as an action item for any project involving company information change.

The SERFF Administrator would need to be notified by the company when changes have been made.

If a filing is reviewed at Intake the Company filers may have typed in the wrong company name or not the full legal name of the company, they would go back to their configuration manager to have it corrected before resubmitting a filing.

When we discover an error.

Rarely a company name change was needed if a filing did not match the info on the company license

When something changes (like a move to a new address).

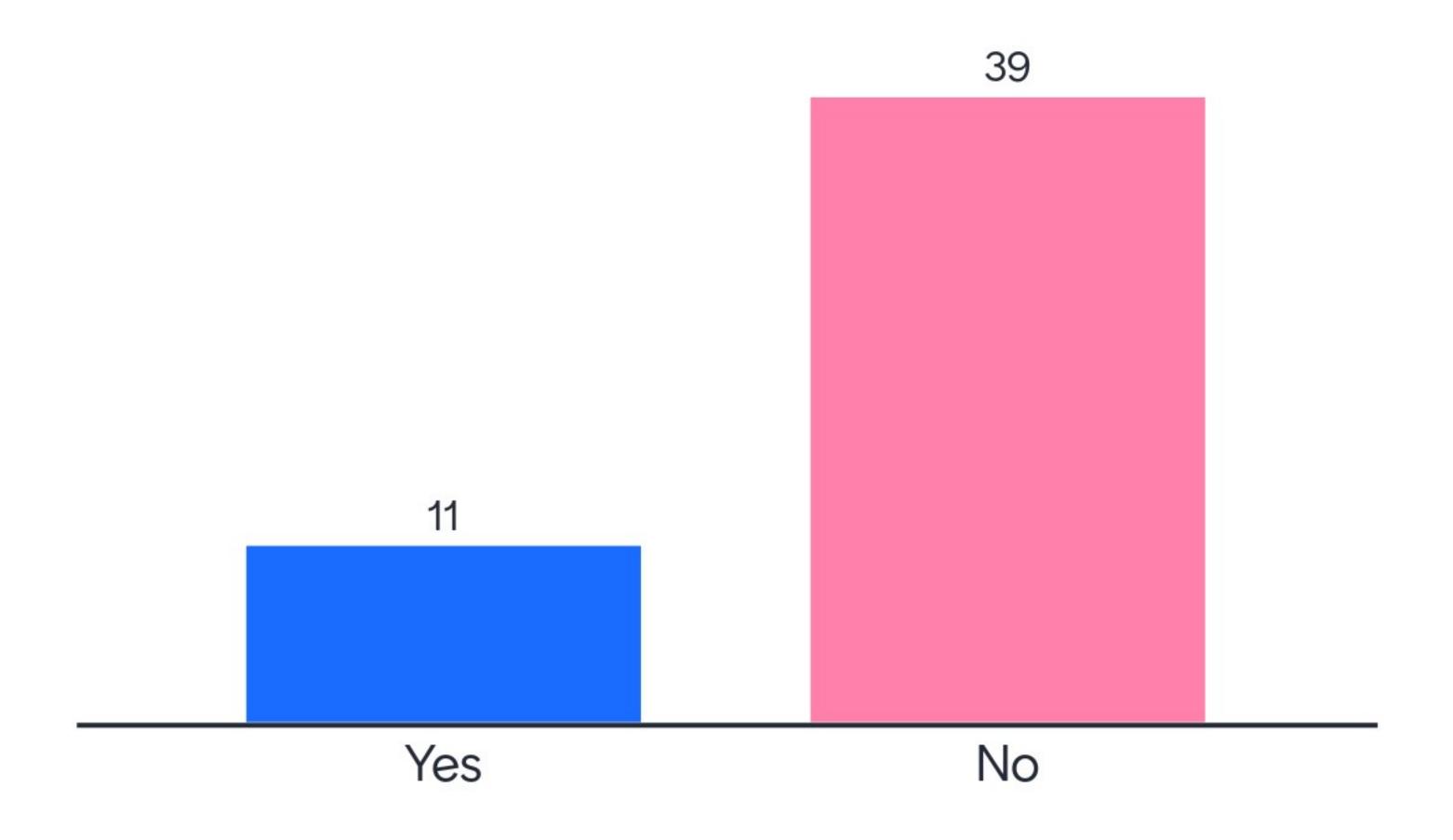
I normally get a email from a person in insurance institutions they notify me when a Name Change, or some sort of update to their Changes to busness operations has occured and I follow up with an email to that person,

Failure to pay filing fees, incorrect TOIs and Sub/TOIs, Incorrect filing types Intake will review whether there is a five digit cocode and will look up the StateID number in the state system to verify both belong to same company

Upon submission, I'll also add incorrectly uploading forms.
