# Roll Call

## Update on Initial Release

- In July, we announced that the first release of the modernized SERFF platform would “go live” on November 11.
- As a reminder, this release includes functionality for Interstate Compact filings and a self-service user management module.
- In November, we announced that the release would be delayed.



# What Happened?

- Performance and load testing indicated the potential for slow response times in production.
- We discovered some data migration issues that need to be corrected.
- Production rehearsal revealed work needed on deployment processes.
- Industry training and user acceptance testing yielded feedback we wanted to address.
- Discussed with Compact leadership, who supported a delay.

# Where are We Now?

- Response times under load are much improved.
- Migration scripts reviewed and adjusted where needed.
- Second rehearsal being scheduled.
- Minor adjustments being made to improve functionality and usability, time permitting.

**All these changes need to be thoroughly tested.**

- Team continues to work toward establishing a new date.
- Intend to provide four weeks' notice to end users.
- Look at for information to start flowing in January!

# User Migration Reminder

- As part of the first release, and to support the self-service module, all active SERFF users will be migrated into the NAIC single sign on system, called Okta.
- People already using another NAIC system will already be in Okta and their legacy SERFF ID and their Okta ID will be linked.
- People not already in Okta will receive an email to activate their Okta account.
- There is no impact to credentials for the Legacy system.
- The credentials for the new platform are the Okta credentials.
- Additional communication and instructions are in the works.
- The new system will have multi-factor authentication.
- Please clean up users! Add valid emails, deactivate as needed.

## Further Impact of Delay

- We still plan to release over a weekend - 5 pm CT Friday to 7 am CT Monday downtime for legacy system.
- We still plan on a "warranty" period to address any issues and continue refinement of Release 1 features.
- The team is working on strategies to reduce domino effect on future phases.



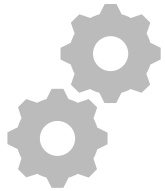


# Value Delivered

- Self-service user management to reduce wait and improve security.

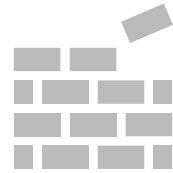


# Building on the Foundation

# Vision Statement

- Enabled Generative AI Help Center for first release.
- Upgraded Form Number extraction model for reliability and speed gains.
- Preparing for proof of concept with AWS Generative AI Innovation Center.
- Establishing infrastructure.
- Implementing governance and quality controls.
- Curating data sets for consistent experimentation and testing.
- Evaluating advantages of various large language models (LLMs) and traditional machine learning techniques.

# Q&A

## December 2024 PSC Meeting Q&A

- Where would we find the statement of intent certification?
  - In the new platform, we're transitioning the Statement of Intent certification to a supporting document item. There are some capabilities around certifications in general that we'd like to explore, but for the interim, it will become a supporting document.
- Are there any updates regarding the PDF Pipeline?
  - As of right now, this is still a work in progress. We expect to release PDF Pipeline in the warranty period.
- Will it be possible to have more than one instance of SERFF open at a time?
  - We will still have instance switching. We are interested in hearing more context and feedback surrounding scenarios of when users would want more than one instance open at a time and reasoning behind that.
- Is two-factor authentication necessary in the new platform?
  - Yes, this is an NAIC security strategy and not specific to SERFF.
- What is the updated timeline with this delay, and work for P&C, etc.?
  - We are working on strategies to minimize any delays, and we'll have some additional information on the new timeline next quarter.
- When AI is added will there be an additional cost to state regulators?
  - No.
- Has any more time/effort been devoted to figuring out how to get users notifications for things like note to filer/note to reviewer? Checking each filing every day is not realistic and a big downgrade.
  - We recently identified places where a notification email wasn't being generated. E-mail notifications have been implemented for Notes.
- For users that currently use Okta for non SERFF related systems, will we receive a separate login for the new SERFF platform?
  - If you have OKTA credentials for NAIC applications like SBS or iSight, your login for the Modernized SERFF platform will be the same as that username/password. You will also still have your old legacy login credentials too because legacy SERFF is not in OKTA.
- I was going to renew our Compact membership, but the 2025 rates that are posted are marked Draft Copy and look like a redlined version. Are these rates correct?
  - Per the Compact, 2025 Compact Registration rates are red lined because they don't take effect until 2025. These rates are adopted, and will be taking effect on January 1, 2025.
- In the new SERFF Platform, will there be a report that we can access that tells us an average time frame that state reviewers review filings and objection responses.
  - This question will be taken back to the SERFF team for review.
- Can you still search on inactive users if they are deleted?
  - Yes.
- Can we download excel spreadsheet into the statement of intent for the first release?
  - This functionality will not be available in Release 1.

- Can a demo be provided on how to add associated filings?
  - Yes, we can add this to a future PSC meeting.
- Will the file size limitation remain the same in the new platform?
  - A definitive file size limitation has not been set in the new platform yet. We will be watching performance and will determine a necessary file size limitation if needed.
- Will the Compact be allowing public access exemptions. If so, is there a process?
  - Per the Compact, a Filing Information Notice was sent earlier in 2024 that details the trade secret process for the Compact. This will remain the same in the new platform.
- Will EFT report be similar to what SERFF currently has?
  - It is our intent that it will be similar. Reporting is one piece we are still working on, but our plan is to offer more flexible reporting capabilities.
- Will there be any way for filers to know where they are in the queue for a given filing? The hope would be to cut down on status requests by offering this type of self-service for filers
  - This question will be taken back for review.
- In the new SERFF platform, will state reviewers be able to run a report showing monthly numbers? Example being, how many forms and rates for a particular time frame?
  - Reporting is one piece we are still working on, but our plan is to offer more flexible reporting capabilities.
- Will the new SERFF still be called SERFF once it launches?
  - The application will still be called SERFF, but we are speaking internally about temporary distinctions between SERFF Legacy and the modernized platform.
- Please consider allowing users to select to receive e-mails in a daily/weekly digest instead of individually. This is sounding like it will require filters to not wreak havoc on our inboxes
  - This item will be taken back to the team for review.
- Are there SERFF features related to Compact filings that are unique, such as selections related to mix and match filing process?
  - It's comparable to what you see today in that the Compact has things like included states, state fees, statement of intent that are specific to the compact. I don't think we've introduced anything new that's unique to the Compact.
- Will the 2025 Updated Compact Fees be integrated in the AI filing fee calculation?
  - The Filing Fee Calculations are not AI, but unless a filer needs to override or adjust, most fee scenarios will be auto-calculated.
